Each year Methodist churches throughout Virginia raise funds to support Randolph-Macon Woman's College and five other educational institutions. In 2005–06 the Virginia Conference supported the College's general operations with a \$238,421 donation. Of that amount, \$57,776 provided student scholarships for Virginia United Methodist Church members, with the remainder going to the R-MWC Annual Fund. The Church's ongoing commitment to higher education provides critical support for the College's need-blind admissions policy by providing funds not restricted to need-based criteria. This enables R-MWC to offer abundant opportunities for young women to receive a quality education.

UNITED METHODIST HIGHER EDUCATION FOUNDATION

Randolph-Macon Woman's College received funds from the Foundation Scholars Program of the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation in the amount of \$4,000 for the 2005–06 academic year.

The United Methodist Higher Education Foundation's Grand Vision is that it be economically possible for any qualified United Methodist student to be educated at a United Methodist-related institution of higher education. Its purpose is to raise, manage, and distribute funds to foster education in a Christian context in schools, colleges, universities, and theological schools within The United Methodist Church and other institutions approved by the Board of Trustees. Since its founding, Foundation assets have grown to over \$40 million. Scholarship program awards totaling more than \$15 million have been made.

VIRGINIA FOUNDATION FOR INDEPENDENT COLLEGES

Randolph-Macon Woman's College joins 14 other privately supported Virginia colleges and universities in extending our sincere thanks and appreciation to the Virginia Foundation for Independent Colleges (VFIC). A joint fund-raising organization established by and for the benefit of its member colleges, the VFIC has been making contributions to R-MWC for more than 30 years. Contributions from business and community leaders are distributed to the non-tax supported member colleges and universities according to a standard formula: 40 percent on the basis of undergraduate enrollment and 60 percent divided equally.

VFIC contributions are vital to the College's annual general operations. VFIC funds support scholarships, fellowships, and library resources and are a critical source of support for the R-MWC Annual Fund. In 2005–06 the VFIC raised gifts and endowment payouts of \$3,000,000; of that sum, R-MWC received \$158,637.
